

Legacy Preserves: Accessibility Guidelines

Policy and Assessment Concerning the Use of Other Power Driven Mobility Devices in Legacy Land Conservancy Preserves

Policy:

Vehicles are prohibited in Legacy Land Conservancy Preserves UNLESS they satisfy the following criteria:

- · are operated by a person with a mobility disability
- · are battery/electric powered
- · weigh less than 300 pounds
- · are no wider than four feet

Legacy Land Conservancy prohibits the use of gas-powered mobility devices on our preserves. These vehicles may pose serious harm to the immediate environment or natural resources.

Battery-powered mobility devices are permitted. They do not interfere with the preserve's design and operational characteristics, and do not pose a risk of serious harm to fragile flora or fauna.

The purpose of a preserve is to protect the native flora and fauna of a natural area. To minimize impact only quiet recreational uses such as hiking, bird-watching, cross-country skiing and nature study are permitted. Natural areas are fragile and can be damaged by improper use. Therefore, we urge you to use caution when using our trails. Please contact the Legacy Land Conservancy to determine which trails are most accessible prior to your visit.
