**Description:** Small nonprofit land conservancy seeks seasonal stewardship crew to implement management plans on preserves and work with volunteers to monitor conservation agreement properties. Preference will be given to students with grant or work study funding.

#### Program Implementation

- Invasive species control
- Trail maintenance
- Monitoring on conservation easement properties
- Native plant seed collection and care
- Keep accurate records of work performed using database software

#### Volunteer Engagement

- Lead stewardship workdays engaging members from the public in Legacy's mission
- Work with Legacy staff to hold training sessions for volunteers
- Coordinate and manage volunteers

#### Desired Skills:

- Knowledge of local fauna and ecology types
- Experience with and ability to use hand and power tools
- Comfortable leading groups of volunteers and teaching others how to perform simple tasks

#### Other Requirements:

- Background in natural resources management including invasive species
- Able to work as part of a team and depend on others
- Must be able to work efficiently outdoors in varying conditions and terrain
- Valid Michigan driver's license
- Enthusiasm for Legacy's work and mission
- Sense of humor
